Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) Education

We offer individualized and group education for clients with COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease). Education includes: assessment, reviewing of inhaler technique, self-management skills, action plans, and regular follow-up.

Pulmonary Rehabilitation

Pulmonary rehabilitation (PR) is a supervised exercise program designed for people with COPD. The three components of a PR program include: exercise, education and self-management. Participating in a Pulmonary Rehab program will decrease symptoms and increase ability to function in daily life.

Patients must be diagnosed with COPD to meet referral criteria for Pulmonary Rehab. COPD is diagnosed by spirometry, which is a painless breathing test that takes just a few minutes.

Pulmonary Rehabilitation Maintenance

The Pulmonary Rehab Maintenance is a supervised exercise program designed for COPD clients who have recently graduated (within the past year) from a recognized program, including programs at The Ottawa Hospital, Pembroke Regional Hospital and Montfort Hospital.
